PRELIMINARY PROGRAM

Working group on Myocardial and Pericardial Diseases of the European Society of Cardiology will organize its Conference in 2006 in two steps. The first step will be held in **Venice, Italy, on February 16-17, 2006** mostly concentrated on hypertrophic and dilated cardiomyopathy with two special sessions on ARVC and amyloidosis.

The second step will be held in **Belgrade, Serbia and Montenegro, on October 6-8, 2006**. This meeting will be more clinically oriented and concentrated on myocarditis, inflammatory and viral heart disease, pericardial diseases, and left ventricular dysfunction. The meeting will also include joint sessions with the Heart Failure Association of the ESC and European League Against the Rheumatism (EULAR).

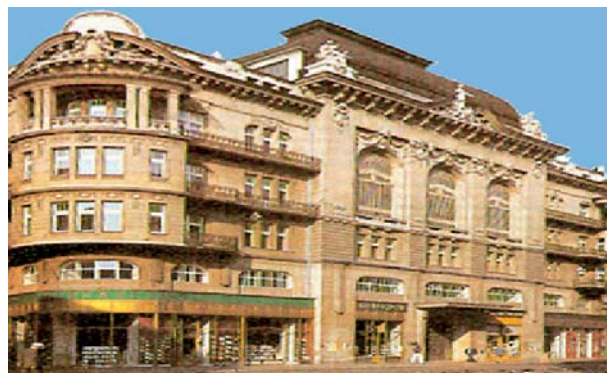
